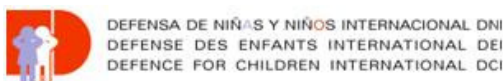

The Interagency Panel on Juvenile Justice (IPJJ) is a group mandated by the Economic and Social Council to coordinate the provision of technical advice and assistance in juvenile justice (ECOSOC resolutions 1997/30, 2007/23 and 2009/26) . The objective of this ancillary meeting organised in parallel to the 12th Crime Congress is to provide governments and other actors involved in justice matters with examples of how to adopt a comprehensive approach to juvenile justice reform as advised by the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child in General Comment No. 10 on "Children's rights in juvenile justice" (2007). Members of the Panel will also discuss promising practices and lessons learned.
